

Covid 19

As the world as we know has changed through the Covid 19 pandemic, inevitably it is the poorest of the poor who have been worst affected.

Both Alex of Mustard Seed Romania and Nelu of Asociata Vieti Schimbata – (name means Association for Changed Lives, referred to as AVS) asked if we could assist them as they tried to help those they knew of in the greatest need in the Bihor county of Romania.

Alex mentioned the lack of information and awareness in the rural villages he works in and began including information sheets and soap with the food parcels he gave out.

Nelu wrote:

“We received some milk for coffee and gave to all our contacts in Oradea and they were happy.

Afterwards I went back to one mother with a package of food, she has 2 children (9 months and 18 months) and the only thing that they had to eat was the milk for the coffee. They don't have work so no money.

Then we had a desperate request for food from 3 poor villages near Oradea (we gave them shoeboxes so they know us) they are in a desperate situation. Called me to ask for food because their children don't have anything to eat. In those villages there are over 900 living in poverty just 40 km from Oradea. If somebody wants to donate to give us a helping hand then it is possible some of these families will survive....”
